The purpose of this notice is to inform you that all settlements involving DRAM have been granted final approval by the Court. If you directly purchased DRAM in the United States during the period of April 1, 1999 through June 30, 2002 from any of these defendants, you may be a member of the Settlement Class.

Also, if you entered into a settlement with any defendant for your purchases from that defendant, or assigned or transferred your claim for any purchases, your Claim Form must not include, as part of your claim, any of those purchases.
